Camping Rules & Regulations

- 1. The Rolling Hills Reservoir Campground is privately owned and operated by the Eastern Irrigation District (EID). Please use respect and obey these rules for everyone's safety and enjoyment.
- 2. Camping is permitted in designated areas only. Fireworks and paper lanterns are prohibited.
- 3. Only 6 seasonal sites, A24, A28, A34, A43, A48 and A88 have two 30 amp outlets, and may be occupied by 2 camping units. The second unit must pay the nightly cost of camping. Tents occupied by children under 18 years of age do not count as an additional unit.
- 4. Two tents per site. No exceptions.
- 5. A maximum of two campsites can be booked per person at the time of reservation.
- 6. Individual campsites may not be reserved but campers may call the Campground Office at (403) 363-5603 to hold an available site the same day, with credit card payment; but must show up by 8:00 pm that evening to claim the site or the site will be forfeited.
- 7. **Eligible irrigators** may reserve a site 48 hours in advance, with payment by credit card. The camper on site must be the irrigator who made the reservation and specific sites cannot be reserved unless a preferred site becomes available at time of check in.
- 8. Group campsite areas may be reserved up to two seasons in advance through the EID Office by calling (403) 362-1400 during business hours.
- 9. The maximum stay for individual or group campsites is 14 nights. At the end of that time, the camping unit must leave the entire campground for a minimum of 48 hours. Doubled up sites must vacate at the end of the two-week maximum, from the first night of the first unit, to prevent revolving sites.
- 10. All camping units and tents must remain on the graveled campsite pad. Grassed areas are irrigated nightly.
- 11. Please keep all personal property on your campsite as the EID is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.

- 12. Alcohol is not permitted away from occupied campsite or in any public areas, including the beaches and boat launch.
- 13. The EID is not responsible for power surges.
- 14. Garbage bins and dumpsters are provided, please do not litter, or burn garbage in fire pits.
- 15. "Quiet Time" is between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am. No unregistered guests after 11:00 pm. Children must remain in campsite after 11:00 pm. In consideration of other campers' generators, music, loud television or radio, loud voices, idling vehicles, and barking dogs are not allowed during "Quiet Time".
- 16. EID staff will lock the gate at the entrance as a method of controlling access to the campground during the "Quiet Time" period from 10:30 pm to 7:00 am. A one way, "exit only" gate may be used to exit the campground whenever the entrance gate is locked. Washroom/shower, laundry building is also locked from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.
- 17. All pets are to be kept under control and within the boundaries of the campsite, and **on a maximum 6-foot leash** when leaving the campsite at all times. No dog stakes and rope on the grass. Pets are not allowed on the public beaches. There is a "dog" beach located between the main beach and marina. The pet owner is responsible for cleaning up after his/her pet.
- 18. Cutting down, damaging, or removal of trees or plant life is prohibited. Firewood is available for purchase at the Campground Office until 8:00 pm.
- 19. Fires are to be always attended and under adult supervision. Fires must be contained within the fire pits provided. Campground staff have the authority to extinguish fires that are not properly supervised or controlled.
- 20. Golf carts and off-road vehicles are not permitted within campground boundaries.
- 21. Please keep your vehicles on designated roads and parking areas.
- 22. The speed limit is 10 km per hour within the entire campground. These speed limits are strictly enforced for the safety of all campers, as well as dust control.
- 23. Use of the beaches and reservoir are at your own risk, no lifeguard is provided.

- 24. Boat slip permits are available for purchase, for daily or weekly use from the Campground Office. Seasonal slips are available for purchase from the EID Office.
- 25. Boats and trailers may be left in the marina parking lot or on your campsite pad, all at the owner's risk. Neither boats nor trailers are permitted on the campsite grassed area at any time, or on road surfaces, as the beach and upper beach roads are too narrow. Excessive vehicles will be asked by EID staff to park in the day use parking lot.
- 26. Trailered boats are to be launched at the campground marina boat launch only.
- 27. All watercrafts must be registered with the EID's Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Program.
- 28. Boater's speed limit within 30 meters from shore is 10 km per hour. Boats are not permitted in the swimming areas.
- 29. Campsite watering and grass cutting are done by EID staff. Campers are responsible for removal of all personal property from the grassed areas. The EID will not be responsible for damage to the personal property of the camper.
- 30. Camping units are to back up to the cement curb and not overhang the back of the trailer or slide-outs on the grass. This makes it easier for mowing.
- 31. No wind fences on daily sites unless approved by campground staff.
- 32. Campers are responsible for the actions of their guests.
- 33. Campers are responsible for any damage they cause to the campsite, campground facilities, or equipment.
- 34. Please leave your campsite in the condition in which it was received.
- 35. Any disregard for the rules and your campsite rental may be terminated immediately with no refund. The campsite must be vacated immediately.
