BYLAW 940 (2020)

Being a Bylaw of the Eastern Irrigation District to Set the Date for a Plebiscite

WHEREAS the Board of Directors proposes to make a bylaw to change the expansion limit of the District from the existing limit of 311,000 acres to 340,000 acres;

AND WHEREAS Section 12 of the Act requires that a plebiscite to obtain the approval of the irrigators be held to approve a bylaw to change the expansion limit;

AND WHEREAS Section 53 of the Act requires:

- a) that the date of an election, including a plebiscite, be prescribed by bylaw;
- b) and that the bylaw be passed at least 3 months before the date of the plebiscite;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Eastern Irrigation District hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "**2020 Plebiscite Date Bylaw**".
2. Definitions:
When used in this Bylaw,
 - (a) "Act" means the Irrigation Districts Act, being chapter I – 11, RSA 2000.
 - (b) "Board of Directors" means the Board of Directors of the District.
 - (c) "District" means the Eastern Irrigation District or the geographic area contained within the boundary of the Eastern Irrigation District, as the case may require.
3. The date of the plebiscite to obtain the approval of the irrigators with regard to a bylaw to change the expansion limit of the District from the existing limit of 311,000 acres to 340,000 acres shall be **November 17, 2020**.
4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date that it is finally passed.
