DAILY CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS
Rolling Hills Reservoir Campground

1. The Rolling Hills Reservoir Campground is privately owned and operated, please use respect, and obey these rules for everyone's safety and enjoyment.
2. Camping is permitted in designated areas only. Fireworks and paper lanterns are prohibited.
3. **Only 14 daily sites, A24, A29, A30, A33, A34, A37, A38, A41, A42, A46, A49, A50, A64 & A89 have two 30 amp outlets, and may be occupied by 2 camping units. The second unit must pay the nightly cost of camping. Tents occupied by children under 18 years of age do not count as an additional unit.**
4. Individual campsites may not be reserved, excepting eligible water users, however campers may call the Campground Office at (403) 363-5603 to hold an available site the same day, with credit card payment; but must show up by 8 pm that evening to extend, or the site will be forfeited.
5. **Eligible water users** may reserve a site 48 hours in advance, with payment by credit card, of the first night's stay. The water user that makes the reservation must be the camper staying on the site. Specific sites may not be reserved, however if a preferred site is available at the time of check in, the camper may change sites at that time.
6. A water user may extend his/her stay, up to a maximum of 14 nights, by registering prior to 48 hours before 8:00 p.m. on the last night paid. After which time, the water user can extend his/her stay on that campsite only if the campsite has not otherwise been reserved.
7. **Campers wishing to remain in their site must "re-register" with payment on their last paid night, before the office closes at 8 pm. Check out is 12 noon. Failure to do so may result in your site being rented to another camper. **This will only apply if the site is not reserved as per rule 5.**
8. Group campsite areas may be reserved up to two seasons in advance through the District Office, or by calling (403) 362-1400, during business hours.
9. The maximum stay for individual or group campsites is 14 nights. At the end of that time, the camping unit must leave the entire campground for a minimum of 48 hours. Doubled up sites must vacate at the end of the two week maximum, from the 1st night of the first unit, to prevent revolving sites.
10. All camping units and tents must remain on the graveled campsite pad. Grassed areas are irrigated nightly.
11. Please keep all personal property on your campsite. The EID is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
12. **The EID is also not responsible for power surges.**
13. Garbage bins and dumpsters are provided, please do not litter or burn garbage in firepits.
14. "Quiet Time" is between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am. In consideration of other campers, generators, music, loud television or radio, loud voices, idling vehicles and barking dogs are not allowed during "Quiet Time".
15. EID staff will lock the gate at the entrance to the campground as a method of controlling access to the campground during the Quiet Time period from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. A one way, "exit only" gate may be used to exit the campground whenever the entrance gate is locked. Washroom/shower, laundry building is also locked from 11:00 pm until 7:00 am.
16. Alcohol is not permitted off of the occupied campsite or in any public areas, including the beaches and boat launch.
17. All pets are to be kept under control and within the boundaries of the campsite, and **on a maximum 6 ft. leash** when removed from the campsite at all times. Pets are not allowed on the public beaches. There is a "dog" beach located between the main beach and marina. The pet owner is responsible for cleaning up after his/her pet. No dog stakes & rope on the grass.

18. Cutting down, damaging or removal of trees or plant life is prohibited. Firewood is available for purchase at the Campground Office until 8 pm. nightly. Please do not tie anything to the trees.
19. Fires are to be attended and under adult supervision at all times. Fires must be contained within the fire pits provided. Campground staff have the authority to extinguish fires that are not properly supervised or controlled.
20. Use the beaches and reservoir at your own risk. No lifeguard is provided.
21. **Golf carts and off-road vehicles are not permitted within campground boundaries.**
22. Please keep your vehicles on designated roads and parking areas.
23. **The speed limit is 10 km per hour within the entire campground. These speed limits are strictly enforced for the safety of all campers, as well as dust control.**
24. Boat slip permits are available for purchase, for daily or weekly use from the Campground Office. Seasonal slips are available for purchase from the District office.
25. Boats and trailers may be left in the marina parking lot or on your campsite pad, all at the owner's risk. Neither boats nor trailers are permitted on the campsite grassed area at any time, or on road surfaces, as the beach and upper beach roads are too narrow.
26. Trailered boats are to be launched at the boat launch only.
27. Boater's speed limit within 30 meters from shore is 10 km per hour.
28. Boats are not permitted in the swimming areas.
29. Campsite watering and grass cutting are done by EID staff. Campers are responsible for removal of all personal property from the grassed areas. The EID will not be responsible for damage to the personal property of the camper.
30. Camping units are to back up to the cement curb. Do no overhang back of trailer on the grass. Slide-outs should not overhang on the grass. This makes it easier for mowing.
31. No wind fences on daily sites.
32. Campers are responsible for the actions of their guests.
33. Campers are responsible for any damage they cause to the campsite, campground facilities or equipment.
34. Please leave your campsite in the condition in which it was received.
35. Any disregard for the rules and your campsite rental may be terminated immediately with no refund. The campsite must be vacated immediately.
